Student Consumer Complaint Process

Out-of-State students who wish to file a complaint related to online courses or programs offered by Grays Harbor College must first seek resolution through the institution's <u>Student Complaint</u> Process.

If the student has fully utilized all internal procedures to address their complaint, and believes that the process has not adequately resolved the complaint the student may contact the Washington Student Achievement Council (WSAC) who has authority to investigate student complaints against specific schools.
